

# Tuesday Night Team Tournament Trail

## 2009 Tournament Rules

- Regular BNBC Tournament rules will govern except as noted below.
- Life jackets are mandatory and must be worn at all times the engine is running. Failure to wear a life jacket will cause disqualification.
- All contestants must be a member in good standing of the BNBC.
- Tournament hours will generally be from 5:30 PM to 9:00 PM, except for 5:45pm start time for Clinton Tourneys. Any changes will be announced prior to take off and will generally depend on the length of daylight.
- To qualify for the year end classic you must physically participate in ten (10) tournaments and are in the top 20 in point standings by Team for best twelve (12) tourneys.
- Tournament entry fee is \$35.00/boat, plus \$5.00/boat for Big Bass.
- Breakdown of \$35.00 entry fee is as follows:
  - Classic Fund           \$6.00 / entry
  - Fish Stocking         \$3.00 / entry
  - Tourney Payout       \$24.00 / entry
  - Team of the year     \$1.00 / entry
  - Trophies, Expenses \$1.00 / entry

- Year end plaques—Team Award. Best twelve (12) point total.
- Points awarded:
  - 1<sup>st</sup>       100
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>       99
  - 3<sup>rd</sup>       98
  - Etc.
- At Lake Bloomington events:
  - Must leave docks ½ hour prior to end of tourney.
  - Must obey lake rules.
  - No wake after dark.
- There will be no practice on lake the day of the tournament.
- Classic tournament site will be announced at the end of the year.
- All Classic teams are responsible for their own lodging arrangements.
- A substitute team member may fish the Classic, if he is a member in good standing, and has fished in 8 events.
